

ESD Symbols

The **ESD susceptibility symbol** incorporates a "reaching hand" in a triangle with a slash through it to indicate that the item so marked is susceptible to ESD damage and should not be touched without ESD safe handling tools. Replicate the following symbol for marking ESD sensitive components and devices.



The **ESD protective symbol** differs from the ESD susceptibility symbol, by the addition of an arc around the outside of the triangle and the omission of the slash across the hand and the triangle. It should be used to identify items that are specifically designed to provide ESD protection, such as for instance packaging. A letter indicates the primary function of the packaging material :

S=Electrostatic Discharge Shielding

D=Electrostatic Dissipative

L=Low Charging

C=Electrostatic Conductive
